

- Any landowner within KCD's service area boundary may apply.
- Applicants will be required to have either a farm conservation plan, forest stewardship plan or be currently receiving technical assistance from KCD staff.
- Applicants may only apply for one best management practice at a time.
- No reimbursements will be made for purchases made before the acceptance letter is received.
- In-kind labor and machinery use is eligible for reimbursement.

King Conservation District's Landowner Incentive Program promotes good stewardship by helping land managers pay for conservation projects on their land. The program refunds 50–90% of project costs with the remainder to be provided by the applicant. Both agricultural and non-agricultural best management practices projects are funded. Currently there is no lifetime maximum on the number of projects a land manager can fund through the program. However, the landowner must complete and receive reimbursement for each funded practice before a new application will be considered.
