RESOLUTION NO. 15-003

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF
THE KING CONSERVATION DISTRICT, KING
COUNTY, WASHINGTON, AWARDING A CONTRACT
FOR CONSTRUCTION ASSOCIATED WITH THE
FAMILY FOREST FISH PASSAGE PROGRAM
SACKWAR AQUATIC ORGANISM PASSAGE PROJECT,
A SMALL PUBLIC WORKS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Chapter 89.08 RCW provides authorization for the King Conservation District (District) to work with landowners to conserve and improve stewardship of natural resources; and

WHEREAS, the District collaborates with the Family Forest Fish Passage Program (FFFPP) to address fish passage barrier issues on private property with willing landowners; and

WHEREAS, the King Conservation District has entered into a grant contract with the Family Forest Fish Passage Program (FFFPP) through the Washington State Recreation and Conservation Office, Washington State Department of Natural Resources, and Washington State Department of Fish and Wildlife to remove a fish passage barrier on the George and Marilyn Sackwar property; and

WHEREAS, the District, in addition and supplemental to Municipal Research and Services Center (MRSC) Public Works and Utilities guidance, has adopted by Resolution 13-001 policies and procedures for planning, implementing, contracting, and constructing Public Works, Small Public Works, and Limited Public Works projects; and


WHEREAS, consistent with MRSC guidance and District policies and procedures for Public Works, Small Public Works, and Limited Public Works projects, the District, implemented a bid process for soliciting goods and services associated with constructing a bridge for the FFFPP-*Sackwar Aquatic Organism Passage Project*; and

WHEREAS, the District policies and procedures direct the Board of Supervisors to award by resolution any contract associated with Small Public Works Projects over \$100,000 in total cost; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District, King County, Washington, as follows:

- 1) Award a contract to *Weber Construction, Inc.* for installation in association with the FFFPP-*Sackwar Aquatic Organism Passage Project*; and
- 2) Authorize the District Executive Director to sign a contract with *Weber Construction, Inc.* for installation of the FFFPP-*Sackwar Aquatic Organism Passage Project* bridge; and
- 3) Authorize District Staff to obtain advanced payment authorization from FFFPP for the *Sackwar Aquatic Organism Passage Project* bridge if needed; and


