A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE
KING CONSERVATION DISTRICT, KING COUNTY,
WASHINGTON, REGARDING THE 2020 ELECTION OF THE
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS


WHEREAS, the three year term of Dick Ryon who holds elected Position #2 on the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District will expire in May of 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District did by Resolution 19-012 formally establish the date for the 2020 election for the expiring term of Position #2 of the Board of Supervisors, and to establish all other requirements and designations required by the Washington State Conservation Commission; now, therefor,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District, King County, Washington, that Section 2 of Resolution 19-012 is hereby amended to include the following sentence: "***Voters may also return print ballots through King County Election ballot drop boxes*** <https://kingcounty.gov/depts/elections/how-to-vote/ballots/returning-my-ballot/ballot-drop-boxes.aspx>." As amended, Section 2 of Resolution 19-012 shall in its entirety as follows:

Section 2: Ballots will be available to eligible voters online beginning January 22, 2020. Voters may return ballot electronically through the online ballot marking systems by 8 p.m. on February 11th, 2020 or print and mail the ballots with a postmark of February 11th, 2020 to King County Elections, 919 SW Grady Way Suite 200, Renton WA 98057. ***Voters may also return print ballots through King County Election ballot drop boxes*** <https://kingcounty.gov/depts/elections/how-to-vote/ballots/returning-my-ballot/ballot-drop-boxes.aspx>. Voters may also receive and/or return ballots at a vote center located at the King Conservation District Office, 800 SW 39th St, Suite 150, Renton, WA 98057. This vote center will be open from 9:00 am through 8:00 pm on Tuesday, February 11th, 2020
