**RESOLUTION NO. 21-001**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE  
KING CONSERVATION DISTRICT, KING COUNTY,  
WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING THE 2021 ELECTION OF  
THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

WHEREAS, the three year term of Jim Haack who holds elected Position #3 on the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District will expire in May of 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District desires to formally establish the date for the 2021 election for the expiring term of Position #3 of the Board of Supervisors, and to establish all other requirements and designations required by the Washington State Conservation Commission; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District, King County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The King Conservation District Board of Supervisors election will be held on Tuesday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021

Section 2. Ballots will be available to eligible voters online beginning March 1, 2021 at 8:00 a.m. Voters may return ballots electronically through the online ballot marking system by 5:00 p.m. on March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021, or print and mail the ballots with a postmark of March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 to King County, Elections, 919 SW Grady Way Suite 200, Renton WA 98057. Ballots postmarked March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2021 will be counted and accepted through March 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Alternatively paper ballots will be available outside of King Conservation Districts main entrance on regular business days from 10:00 a.m.- 5:00 p.m. from March 1, 2021 through March 23<sup>rd</sup>. Section 3. The candidate filing deadline for Position #3 on the King Conservation District Board of Supervisors is January 12, 2021 8:00 a.m. through February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2021, at 5:00 p.m. Candidate required information must be received at the King Conservation District Office, 800 SW 39th St., Suite 150, Renton WA 98057, by mail or by email at [district@kingcd.org](mailto:district@kingcd.org) no later than February 2<sup>nd</sup> 2021 at 5:00 p.m. A candidate who wishes to submit candidate optional information must provide that information no later than February 2, 2021 at 5:00 p.m. or via email at [district@kingcd.org](mailto:district@kingcd.org) or by mail at the King Conservation District Office, 800 SW 39th St., Suite 150, Renton WA 98057. 

Section 5. The King Conservation District Board of Supervisors designates Ava Souza as the Election Supervisor for the 2021 Board of Supervisors Election.

Section 6. The King Conservation District Board of Supervisors directs the Elections Officer to prepare and file all forms as appropriate and deemed necessary with the Washington State Conservation Commission consistent with the terms of this Resolution and to take all actions necessary to accomplish its ends including any filings with any other entities as necessary.


Section 7. All District resolutions, policies and procedures are hereby modified, amended and superseded to be in accordance with this Resolution.
