RESOLUTION NO. 12-008

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE KING CONSERVATION DISTRICT, KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON, ESTABLISHING THE 2013 ELECTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

WHEREAS the three year term of Max Prinsen, elected Position # 1, on the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District will expire in May of 2013; and

WHEREAS the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District desires to formally establish the date for the 2013 election for the vacant position of the Board of Supervisors, and to establish all other requirements and designations required by the Washington State Conservation Commission; now, therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of the King Conservation District, King County, Washington, as follows:

Section 1. The voting period for the 2013 King Conservation District Board of Supervisors election will be from Tuesday, February 26, 2013 at 12:01 a.m.. through Tuesday, March 12, 2013, until 11:59 pm.

Section 2. The method of election balloting will be exclusively by remote electronic voting on the World Wide Web. For any voter without access to the internet a computer station will be available at the King Conservation District Office, 1107 SW Grady Way, Suite 130 in Renton, Washington. This computer station will be open from 9:00am to 5:00pm (PST) Monday through Friday during the entire voting period: Tuesday, February 26 through Tuesday March 12th; 2013 and


Section 3. The candidate filing deadline for the 2013 King Conservation District Board of Supervisors is January 18, 2013, 5:00 pm (PST): and

Section 4. The King Conservation District Board of Supervisors designates Election Trust, LLC as the Election Supervisor for the 2013 Board of Supervisors Election; and

Section 5. The King Conservation District Board of Supervisors directs the Executive Director and staff to prepare and file Form 1, with the Washington State Conservation Commission consistent with the terms of this Resolution and to take all actions necessary to accomplish its ends including filing it with the Commission in a timely manner; and

Section 6. All District resolutions, policies and procedures are hereby modified, amended and superseded to be in accordance with this Resolution.
